

# Macramé Christmas Tree Keyring

## Kit contents:

1x keyring, 1 bead, 1x 50cm cord with taped end, 12 x 10cm cords, 14 x 15cm cords, 1 x tree template

## You will also need:

Sharp scissors, a comb



**Step 1:** Take the long cord with the tape on it and secure it to the keyring using a Larks Head Knot.



**Step 2:** Thread the wooden bead onto the cord using the paper taped end and then push it up to the top.



**Step 3:** Tie an overhand knot underneath the bead.



**Step 4:** Take one of the shorter 10cm cords, fold in half and place it underneath the central filler cords.



**Step 5:** Take another of the 10cm cord, fold it in half and loop it up from the other side through the other cord. Then, thread the ends through and pull both sides tight.



**Step 6:** Repeat steps 4 and 5 with all the remaining cords. Then move on onto the larger 15cm cords, pushing the knots up the filler cords making sure there are no gaps.



**Step 7:** Use the tree template as a guide to cut the sides, leaving about a 1cm margin



**Step 8:** Use a comb to tease out both sides.



**Step 9:** Use the template to trim the sides again.



**Step 10:** Cut off the paper tape end to finish the Macramé tree.
